How does location impact how we experience an artwork? Using the technique of mold making, cast an object and use multiple casts in a sculptural installation that engages with a specific location in the Annie Smith building. When creating the installation, consider how the site, the choice of casting material and the number of pieces cast impact the reading of the work. The cast object(s) and their positioning should relate to and/or respond to specific aspects of the site.

STEPS:

- use a wax cast from Duplication
- take photos of wax cast in various locations within the Annie Smith building
- choose the 2 best photos
- visualize the installation using the site photo –you may use Photoshop, collage, or drawing directly on printouts of photo
- visualize **3** different configurations for your installation

NOTE: Your final Castoff Installation does NOT have to be exactly like your drawing, your idea may develop further on site

Evaluation Criteria:

KEY TERMINOLOGY:

Multiples – a series of identical art objects

Site –

noun: 1. an area or piece of land where something was, is, or will be located
2. a place where something important happened

verb: to locate something in a particular place or position

Installation - an artwork assembled by the artist involving the arrangement of three-dimensional objects or the use other media directly on walls or floors
