

PRINTING FROM PHOTOSHOP CC TO EPSON 7800

Before you begin:

- Make sure you have money in your Papercut account.
- Double check your image size to make sure that your file does not exceed the maximum printing width (**Image > Image Size**) and check your resolution to make sure that you are printing at 300 ppi. The Epson 7800 (in AA2) can print a maximum image width of 23.99".
- If your image has multiple layers, flatten it before printing (**Layer > Flatten Image**).

1) Create a new canvas (**File > New**) that is 23.99" wide. Set the height to whatever you need (the minimum printing height is 5" and the maximum printing height is 90 feet).

2) Copy the image you want to print onto your new canvas. If the image you want to print is smaller than the maximum printing width, you can group multiple images together. This is called *bulk printing* (make sure you flatten your bulk print canvas before printing).

4) Open the print window (**File > Print**).

5) Click the **Print Settings...** button to open the Print settings menu.

6) Click on **Paper Size** and select **Manage Custom Sizes**. Click on the + button to create a custom size.

7) Add your dimensions. Remember: On the Epson 7800, the width must always be 23.99". Make sure the margins are set to 0 all around. Click **OK**.

8) From the Layout drop down menu select **Print Settings...**

9) In the Page Setup menu, select **Roll Paper**. Select **Premium Luster Photo Paper 260** from the Media Type menu. Exit the Print Setting menu.

10) Under the **Colour Handling** menu select **Photoshop Manages Colour**.

11) Under **Printer Profile**, select **Pro9800 7800 PLPP260**.

12) Click **Print**. Do not close Photoshop or log out until your print has come out of the printer.

Note: If you are printing outside of the Technician's hours on the Epson 7800, you will have to come back later to collect your print.
